EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Since late June 2025, Pakistan has faced unprecedented monsoon rains, flash floods, and cloudbursts, resulting in 746 deaths, nearly 1,000 injuries, and the displacement of tens of thousands of families across the country (NDMA, August 2025). The Pak Christian Foundation (PCF) has been actively working on the ground to rescue, support, and provide life-saving assistance to flood victims in some of the hardest-hit areas.

On 19 August 2025, PCF conducted a rapid field assessment in District Buner, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, where hundreds of families had been abandoned and cut off due to flood destruction. Based on the findings, PCF organized a Medical & Humanitarian Relief Camp on 04 September 2025, delivering urgent medical care and essential supplies to over 500 individuals, primarily children and women, who were at severe risk.

This report summarizes the pre-camp assessment, camp execution, human impact, and outlines urgent needs for further action, especially with the harsh winter approaching in mountainous areas over 6,000 ft above sea level.



PRE-MEDICAL CAMP ASSESSMENT (Conducted: 19 August 2025)

Location Assessed:

- ◆ District Buner, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK)
- ◆ Remote mountainous villages situated over 6,000 ft above sea level



KEY FINDINGS:

Location Assessed:

- Entire communities were cut off from relief due to washed-out roads.
- Hundreds of families abandoned, living without shelter, electricity, or clean water.
- Children and women at highest risk due to exposure, malnutrition, and untreated injuries.
- Many individuals became disabled due to flood-related accidents and had no access to wheelchairs or medical support.

Survivors shared painful accounts of:

- Loved ones swept away in the floods, with some bodies still missing.
- Livestock perished, eliminating their only source of livelihood.
- Homes completely destroyed, leaving families to live in makeshift camps or under open sky.

No access to light, gas, medical facilities, or winter preparedness.

Community Feedback:

Survivors were deeply moved by the support, sharing harrowing stories of survival, death, and loss. Many had lost entire families, and are still searching for the bodies of loved ones. The camp became not just a place for treatment but also a source of emotional relief and dignity in a time of despair.

ONGOING CHALLENGES & URGENT NEEDS

As the winter season rapidly approaches, temperatures in the mountainous Buner region can drop to -5°C or lower, with heavy snowfall expected. Lives are at risk.

Urgent Needs Identified:

- Winterized tents and warm clothing
- Food and nutrition support for children and lactating mothers
- More medical camps and mobile health units
- Psychosocial support and trauma care
- Rehabilitation support for disabled and injured individuals
- Long-term shelter solutions
- Fuel, solar lighting, heating sources

Without immediate and sustained intervention, we risk a secondary disaster of hypothermia, starvation, and disease outbreak in these vulnerable communities.

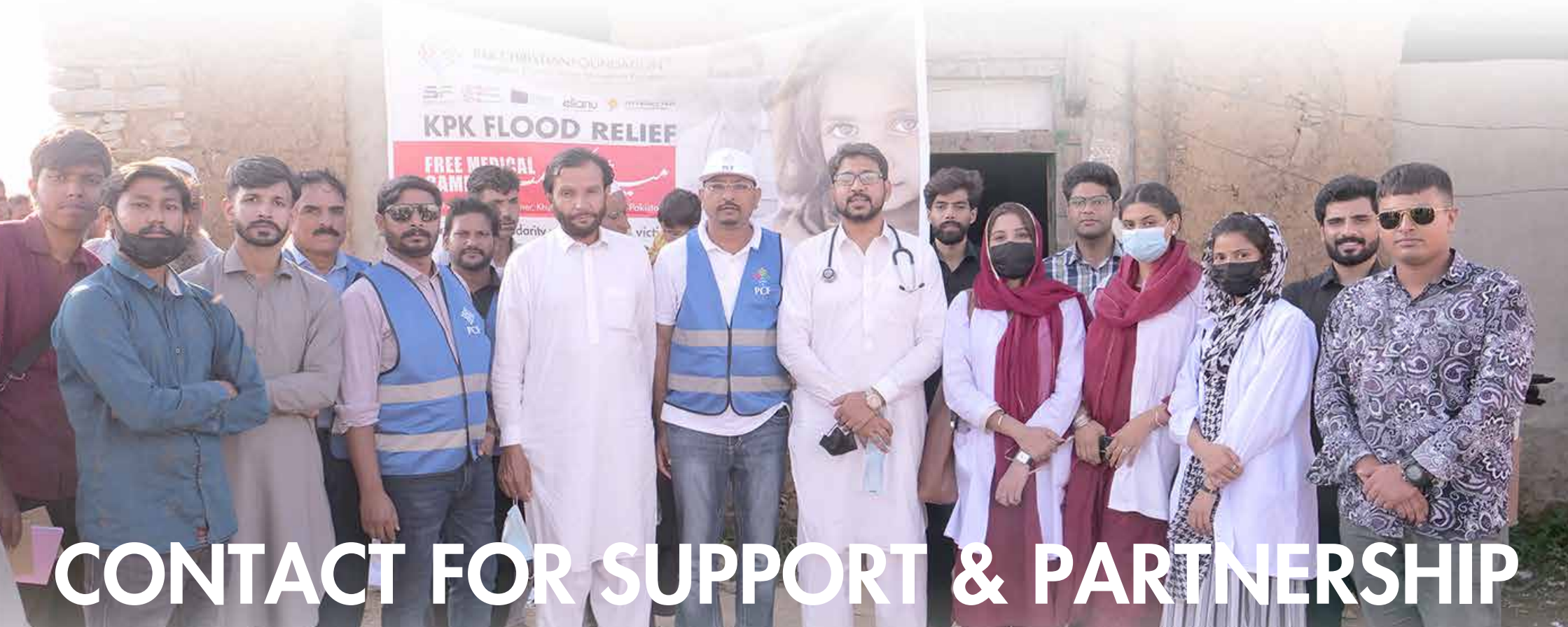
